### COACHES COMPETITION PROCEDURE INFORMATION BULLETIN #3 – SUMMARY

Ethnikos – Two coaches or team officials can be with the archer or team during the warm up period.

Ethnikos to Panathinaiko – Two coaches can travel in the van to Panathinaiko and be in the Waiting Room and walk down the tunnel with the archers. They will be escorted by an ATHOC Marshall. The coach on the Field of Play and archer (team) will leave everything except two bows, one scope, a small quiver and arrows per person in the Waiting Room.

Field of Play (FOP) – Only one coach may go on to the FOP after the archers go on to the FOP and are introduced. The second coach or team official will be escorted to the seats in the first rows of the stadium that are reserved for coaches. During the Finals, archers who are through competing in the 1/4<sup>th</sup> Finals and Semi-Finals may sit in these seats after putting their equipment in the upper Waiting Room.

End of Match – The ATHOC Marshall will escort the archer or team and coach to the Media Mix Zone and then to the lower entrance to the tunnel where they will meet the second coach and be escorted by the ATHOC Marshall up the tunnel to the Waiting Room and pick up their bags. Next they will be escorted by their Marshall to the special vans and be driven to Ethnikos.

NOTE: During the Individual and Team Finals, the archers, coaches and AAs with archers competing in the Finals, may stay at the stadium to observe the remaining matches. However, the archers must store their equipment in the Waiting Room at the top of the tunnel.

The four archers and coaches remaining in the Semi-Finals may stay in the tunnel Staging Area and keep their equipment in a nearby guarded area until the Award Ceremonies are finished. The medal winners must stay in the Staging Area after their matches are completed, as the Award Ceremony will start as soon as possible after the Gold Medal match. Their equipment will be stored in the guarded area during the award ceremony. Anti-Doping tests will follow.

At Ethnikos – The archers and coaches may go directly back to the village or store their equipment at Ethnikos and walk back to the Panathinaiko Stadium to see the competition. The walk is about 5 minutes to the stadium entrance. The access will be through the VIP entrance and the seating will be in the regular athlete seating area on the west side of the stadium.

Return to Village – Either immediately after the archer's competition or after walking back to Ethnikos after viewing some matches, athletes, coaches and team officials will board the buses back to the Olympic Village. Limited practice at Ethnikos can be requested.
